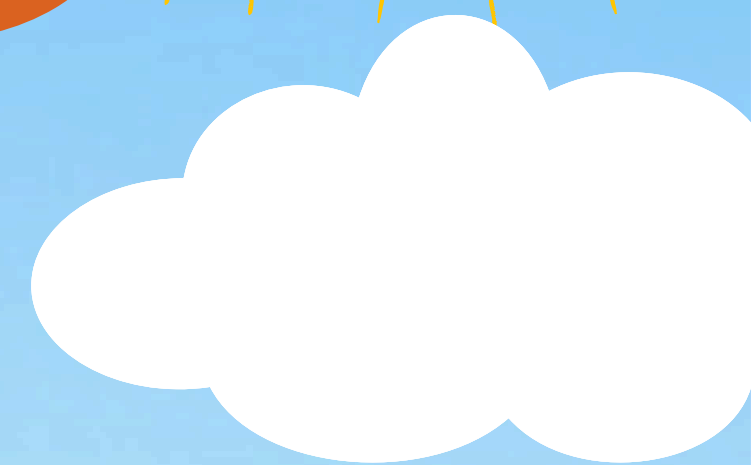
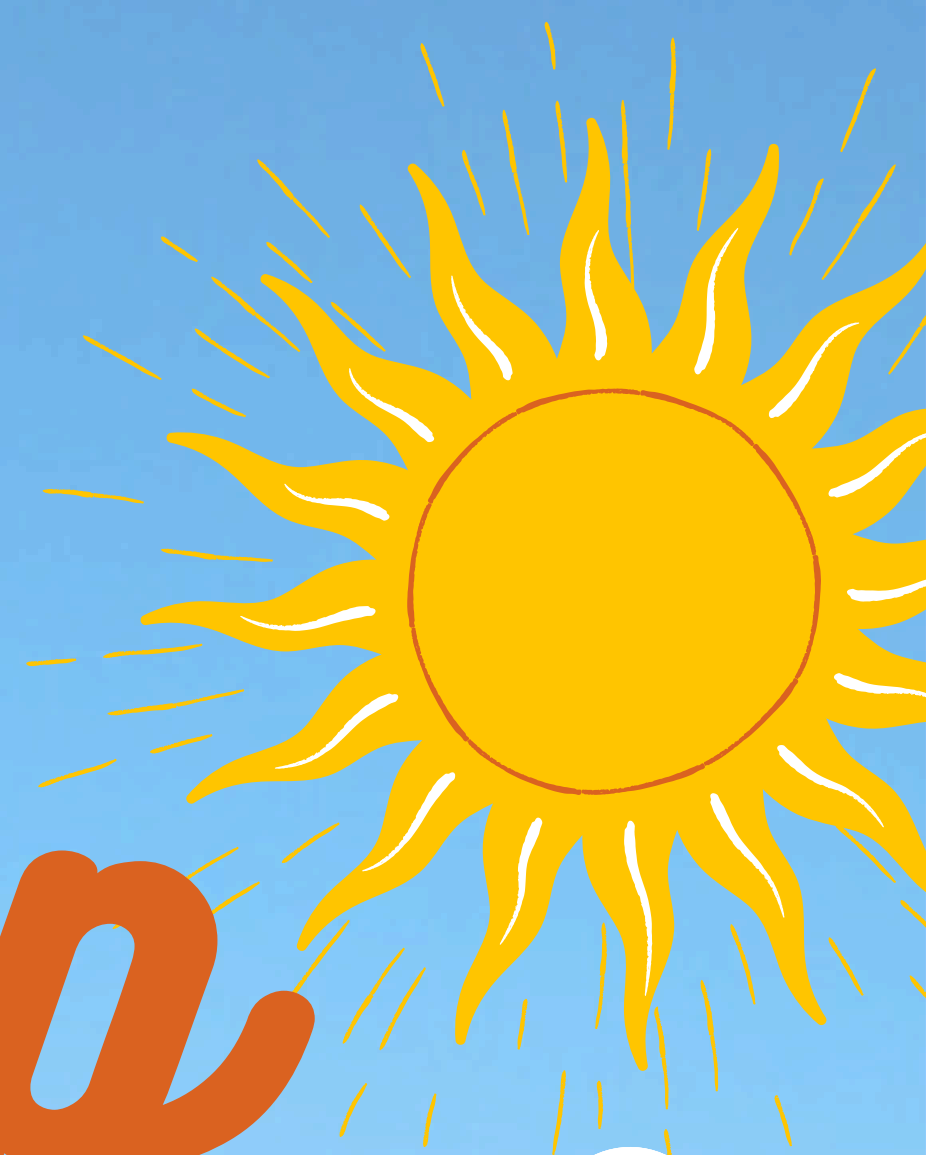

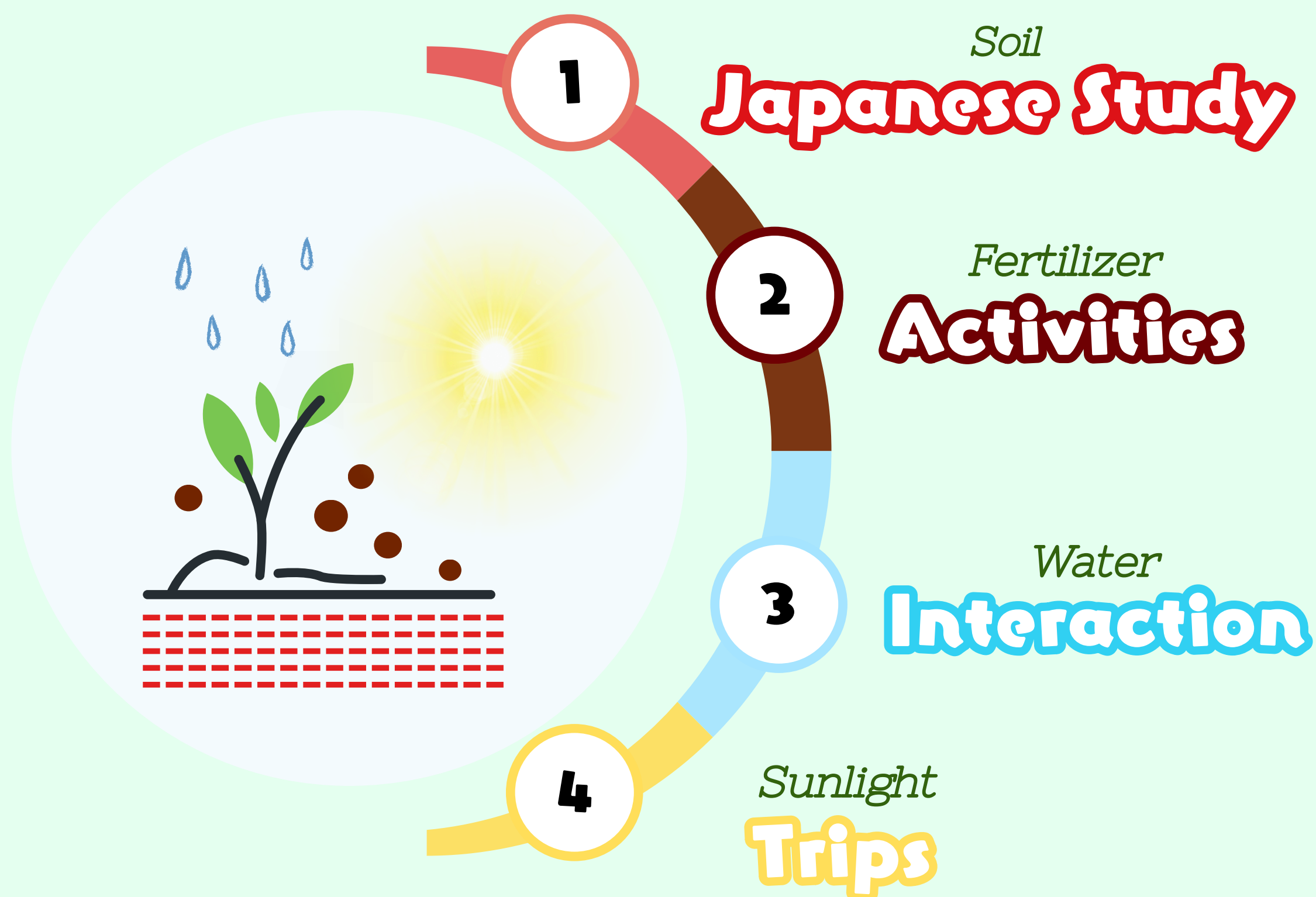


Welcome to an unforgettable summer experience!

- Students can be punctual and follow the program schedule.
- Students can understand the rules and guidelines and act responsibly.
- Students have a way to stay in touch (e.g., smartphone) and can maintain communication. The school uses WhatsApp during the camp
- Students feel comfortable asking for help when needed.

A Special Program for Minors

This program is designed specifically for minors (14-17) who share the same start and end dates, similar levels, and the same age group. Students support one another, creating a friendly and encouraging environment where lasting friendships can grow.

Homestays

Stay with a safe, carefully selected Japanese host family. Experience daily life in Japan and practice what you learn at school in a real home environment. Private rooms are provided with breakfast and dinner included.

**Supervised Residence is available only if there are openings. Availability will be confirmed around April, and until then, students will be placed on a waiting list.*

Airport Pick-Up

A representative will greet the student at the airport and take them safely to their accommodation. We can also coordinate with Unaccompanied Minor Services provided by airlines, ensuring a smooth, worry-free arrival.

Program Overview

Duration: July 6– July 24, 2026 (3-week program)

Location: Genki Japanese and Culture School, Fukuoka, Japan

Accepted Age: 14 – 17 years old

Accepted Level: A0 – A1 (Beginner level)

Capacity: 60 students

Class Size: Max 8 students per class

Cost: 550,000 JPY (Tax included)

Includes:

- Japanese lessons & study materials
- Activities & trips
- Homestay or supervised residence (includes breakfast, dinner and lunch only during trips)
- Round-trip airport transfer (FUK - Accommodation) & ¥20,000 transportation card (500yen deposit)

Note: Homestay provides breakfast and dinner. Lunch is not provided by the homestay. Sunday meals are not included at the supervised residence.

Cancellation & Refund

Cancellation date	Amount Charged
After application – 61 days before program (by May 5, 18:00 JST)	36,000 JPY
60–31 days before program (by June 4, 18:00 JST)	36,000 + 154,200 (30% remaining) = 190,200 JPY
